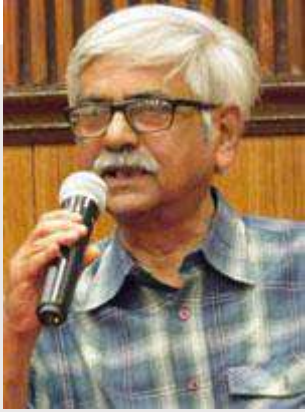

He first served as Reader and, from 2000 onwards, as Professor in the Department of Film Studies. During his tenure, he played a significant role in shaping the academic foundation and intellectual direction of Film Studies at Jadavpur University.

From 2002 to 2004, he served as Director of the School of Media, Communication and Culture, Jadavpur University. He later joined the Government of West Bengal as Director of Roopkala Kendra, a state-run film institute, a post equivalent to the rank of Principal Secretary in the Government. He is also a founder member of the Kolkata International Film Festival, reflecting his deep and enduring engagement with cinema, culture, and public intellectual life.
